

# **HOW TO GET THERE**

#### WILDBAD KREUTH

Nestled in the idyllic landscape between Lake Tegernsee and the Achen Pass, the former spa looks back on 500 years of history. For three hundred years, the "Sankt Leonhard" spa was the property of the Abbots of Tegernsee until secularisation; in 1803, it was sold to a farmer from Kreuth. Only 15 years later, King Max Joseph I of Bavaria (1756-1825) purchased the entire complex and extended it to its present size. The current owner from the Wittelsbach family, Duke Max in Bavaria, closed the sanatorium and the pump house in 1973 and leased the building to the Hanns Seidel Foundation. On September 25, 1975, Wildbad Kreuth opened as an educational center.
