

Information on the hygiene concept for visitors to the DECHEMA building



Obligation to prove negative COVID-19 test or full vaccination or convalescent ID card



Data Check-In with the Luca App



Please keep 1.5 metres away from other people



Please wear a mouth and nose cover, except when at your seat



Please observe the etiquette for sneezing and coughing



No entry with symptoms of sickness, such as a temperature or a cough



Please wash and disinfect hands regularly and thoroughly



Please no handshakes!
Give a smile instead

For DECHEMA the safety and health of our visitors, exhibitors, partners and participants have the highest priority.

Therefore we have developed a hygiene concept with all necessary medicinal, hygienic and organizational measures.

The hygiene concept is based on the current requirements of the updated version of the “Corona regulations for contact and operating restrictions” issued by the state of Hesse.

It is possible that the requirements of the Corona regulation will change once again before your visit, and our rules and/or measures will have to be changed accordingly. You can always find the current hygiene concept on our website www.dechema.de/corona

Should anybody not follow the rules of our hygiene concept, we will make use of our domiciliary rights and will ask them to leave the DECHEMA premises.

**For reasons of better readability, the simultaneous use of the language forms male, female and diverse (m/f/d) is waived. All references to persons apply equally to all genders.*

Obligation to provide evidence

- An official test result (not a self-test) not older than 48 hours must be shown at the reception. Equivalent to this is proof of first and second vaccination with a vaccine approved in the European Union or the convalescent ID card.
- There are several test centers near the DECHEMA building, e.g. at [Frankfurt Central Station](#) or in the [Skyline-Plaza](#), Europa-Allee 6.
Please note that you need to make an appointment there in advance.

Data acquisition

- For contact tracing you have to fill in a self-disclosure form
- To simplify the processes, we use the [Luca app](#) for registration at DECHEMA. In exceptional cases, however, we can also enter the data manually.
- **Please install the Luca app on your smartphone in advance or use the web app:**
The Luca app can be downloaded for free from the Google Play Store and the Apple App Store. When registering, you must provide your name, address and phone number. The data is stored anonymously and encrypted. This means: We as DECHEMA cannot view your data. Please check in with the QR code when entering DECHEMA and check out again on your smartphone when leaving.

General hygiene measures

- Sufficient disinfectant dispensers are available all over the DECHEMA building.
- In the sanitary facilities there are exclusively non-reusable paper towels available.
- The cleaning and disinfection frequency for busy areas and contact surfaces as well as for the sanitary facilities has been increased.
- The DECHEMA building has a ventilation concept. The function rooms are well aired at all times.
- All participants and service providers will be informed about the hygiene concept in advance of their event or their visit.
- Catering is also subject to a hygiene concept.

Distance rules

- A mandatory safety distance of at least 1.5 metres between individuals must be kept. We have introduced a trail system and adapted the seating plans. Please respect the barriers and markings that have been put in place.

Obligation to wear a nose and mouth cover

- It is obligatory to wear nose and mouth cover in the public areas of the DECHEMA building. The nose and mouth cover may be removed once seated.

Observing the etiquette of sneezing and coughing

- Cover sneezes or coughs with a tissue, if possible. Otherwise, please sneeze or cough into the crook of your elbow and turn away from other people.

No entry with symptoms of sickness

- We ask you to stay at home and contact your doctor in case of relevant symptoms of sickness (fever, loss of sense of smell or taste, cough).

Please wash and disinfect your hands regularly

- Many infectious diseases are transmitted via hands. Washing your hands regularly will protect you and others from many germs

Greetings with distance

- We ask you to refrain from hugs and handshakes. Please give each other a smile instead.
